**Thursday, June 1, 2017 – CHANGE -** Hernando Trail In Hot Springs Village, Arkansas (7 miles/moderate)

**Carpools:** Hikers living outside of the village will meet at 9 A.M. outside of the West Gate at the Cordoba Center parking area. To get there, follow Highway 7 from Hot Springs until you reach an intersection on the west side of the village with a set of street lights. At the intersection, make a right turn into the village. Just before you reach the west gate, make a right turn into the Cordoba Center. The parking area faces the Hot Springs Village Visitor's Center. From the parking area we will drive to the trailhead.

The west side of the village is 19 minutes/12.5 miles from Gulpha Gorge. (Carpooling is free)

**The Trailhead:** Meet at the trailhead at 9:20 A.M. Here is how to get there. Drive to the parking area in front of an abandoned medical center on the north side of DeSoto Boulevard. Behind it is the Good Samaritan Retirement Center. The Retirement Center faces Cortez Road. Cortez Road crosses DeSoto Boulevard.

**Bring:** Plenty of water, hiking sticks, and snacks and spray for ticks.

**We should finish** the hike before 1:00 P.M. We can have lunch somewhere in or outside of the village.

**Note:** Some hikers can chose to do only five miles on this hike.

### Saturday, June 3, 2017 - National Trails Day
