### **Lodging/Accommodations:**

In past years the State Park has allowed the club to place a hold on a number of cabins allowing our group to make arrangements and reserve any of the cabins being held. Well, “times they are a changing” ... and a new process is in place. Since we no longer have the ability to put a hold on cabins it means that each participant, or those going in together and sharing a cabin, must reserve their own cabin. The park offers 1, 2 & 3 bedroom cabins along with a couple of smaller studio cabins. Park policy is that any cancellation made up to 5 days prior to the check-in date will receive a full refund.
